## STEP 1 Download the app

### 1 App introduction page

Visit the Japan Post Bank website.



### 2 Go to the app store

Download the app that is compatible with your device.

Prepare your email address and bank account number before registering!



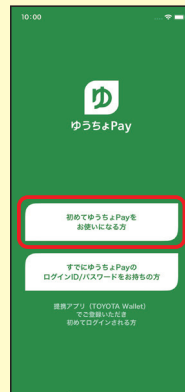
### 2 Service information

Tap "Start using."



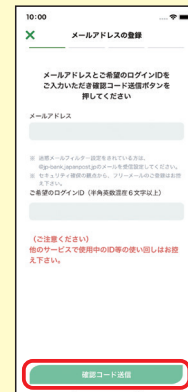
### 3 Login screen

### 4 Register your email address and other information

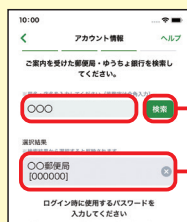
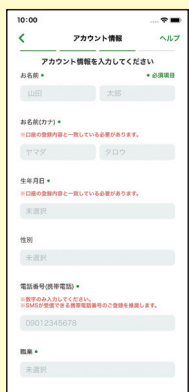
You will receive a confirmation code at your registered email address.

Enter your account details and select the post office or Japan Post Bank where you heard about the app.

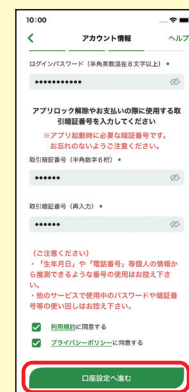


1 Enter the name of the post office or Japan Post Bank and tap "Search."

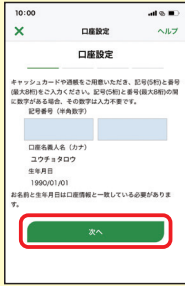

### Authentication via the "Yucho Authentication App"

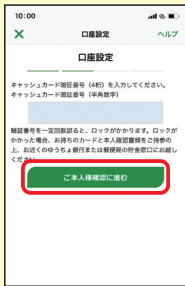
To use the Yucho Authentication App, you need to download the free dedicated app and register your information.

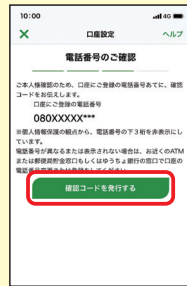
### 3 Input PIN code

Enter the 4-digit PIN code for your bank card.



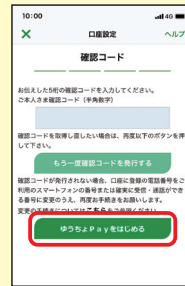
### 4 Identity confirmation

Enter the 5-digit confirmation code.

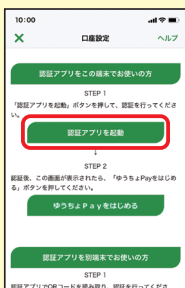

Actual screens are subject to change due to app updates and other factors. ●Data transmission expenses related to app downloads, updates, usage, and other operations are borne by the user.
