

Our apps cannot be used with some residence cards

Residence cards (including specified residence cards) issued on or after June 14, 2026, cannot currently be used as personal identification documents for procedures on the Yucho Tetsuzuki App, Yucho Bankbook App, and Yucho Authentication App. We will continue working with the Immigration Services Agency to update the system. We apologize for any inconvenience and appreciate your understanding.

We will issue a separate notice once these cards can be used with our apps.

1. Yucho Tetsuzuki App

Please visit your local Japan Post Bank or Post Office Savings Counter to complete various procedures using a residence card issued on or after June 14, 2026.

You may be asked to present your passport during the procedure, so please bring it along with your residence card.
